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# Metadata

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These reference tables correspond to those in Figure32, but have zoomed on the period since 1998. In doing so, you can find the changes in the recent two decades much clearer. The graph besides each table shows the fertility rate of that year, and the absolute change over time. The x-axis is the absolute change while the y-axis is the total fertility rate. Each circle represents a certain year.

By zooming on the recent period, the changes in the fertility rate of the more developed countries are more complicated whereas those in the less developed countries are as simple as their predecessors in the 1960s, which have shown a consistent decline.

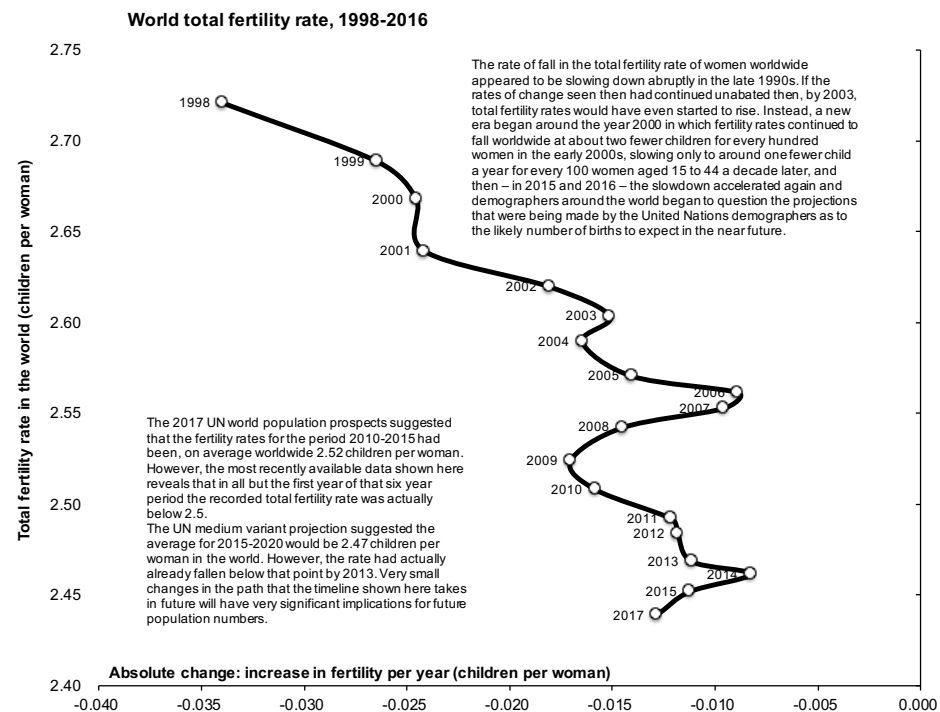

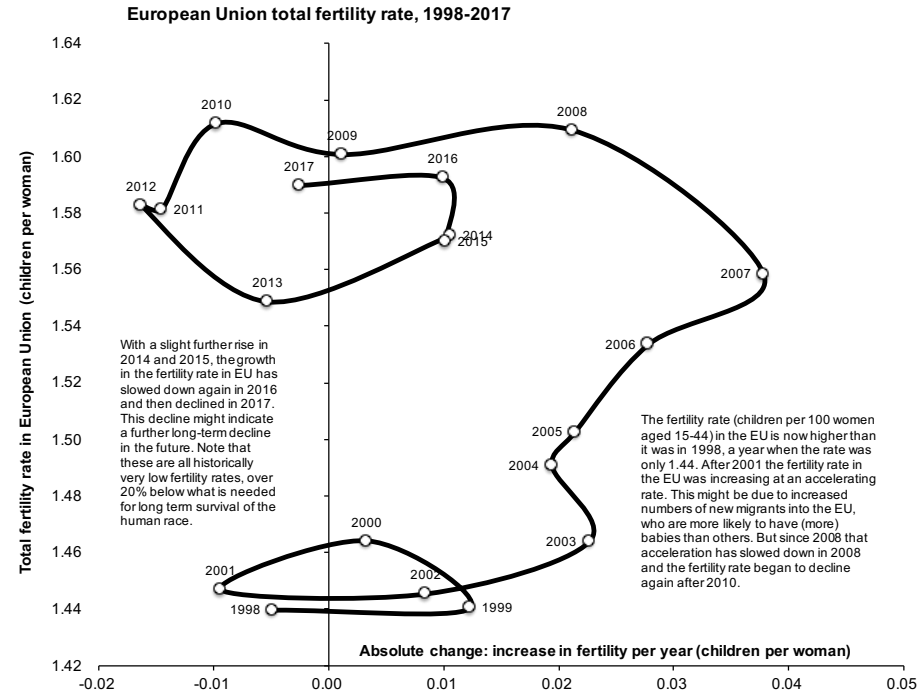

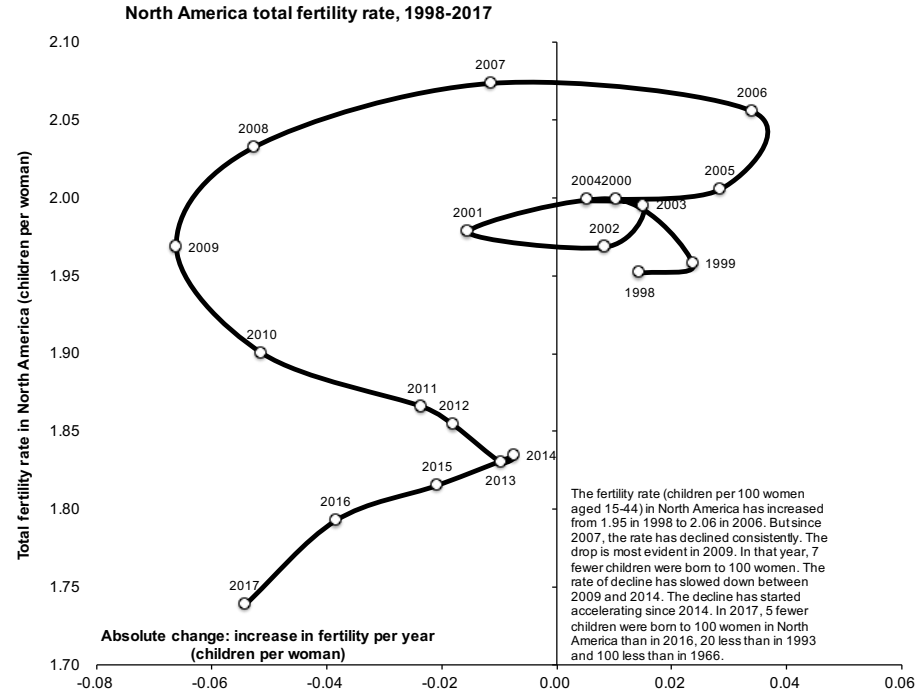

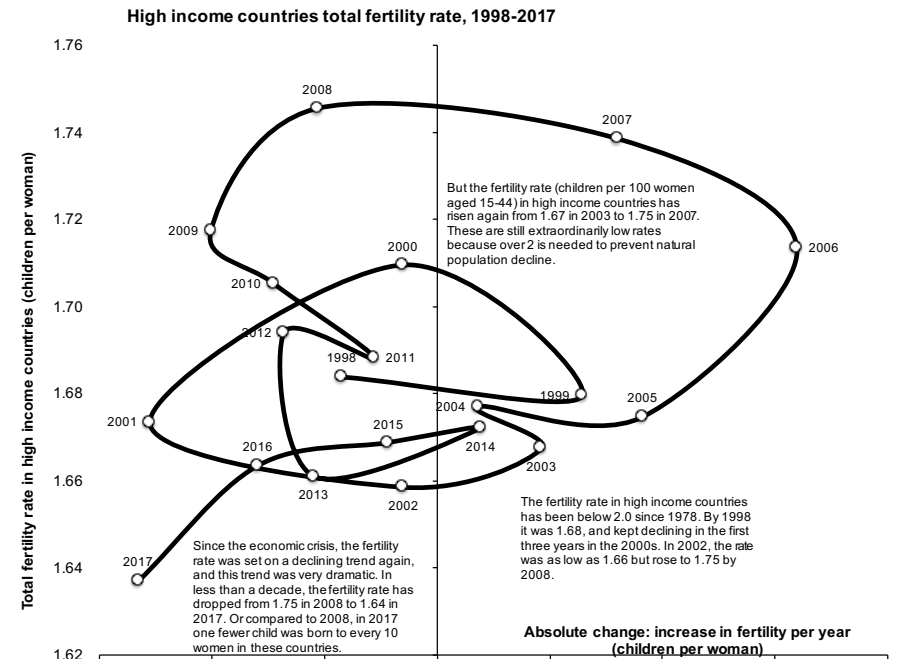
